#### **FEES**

Registration and fees paid by May  $22^{nd} = \$15$  per youth
Registration and fees paid between May  $23^{nd}$  up to 5 pm of the day prior = \$20 per youth
Same day registration and fees or paying on site\* = \$25 per youth
Webelos Overnight Activity = \$5 additional per youth

\*Same Day Registration is <u>ONLY</u> permissible if there is space available. Please call in advance.


### **Day Camp Walk Through**
