

Sled Race:

Sleds should be built by scouts as much as possible !!! All scouts must cross finish line! One scout on sled.

You will need to take your Klondike sled with you from event to event. It should carry: shovels, 40' rope, fire starting materials (no liquids or flares), snacks, water, compasses, short rope pieces, Scout Handbook etc.
