National Youth Leadership Training (NYLT) and Kodiak Experience are exciting, action-packed programs designed to provide youth with leadership skills and experience they can use in their home troops and in other situations demanding leadership of self and others. **Cedar Badge (CB)** is sponsored by the Grand Teton Council and provides an active environment for teaching youth cutting-edge leadership skills. The **Cedar Badge** course centers around the concepts of what a leader must **BE**, what they must **KNOW**, and what they must **DO**. The key elements are then taught with a clear focus on **HOW TO**. The skills come alive during the week as the patrol goes on a Quest for the Meaning of Leadership. **Cedar Badge** is the best training available anywhere!

- Be recommended by their unit or youth leader
