Qualifications to Attend Cedar Badge

- Be registered with Scouts BSA
- Be a First-Class Scout (if Attending Scouts, BSA CB)
- Be age 14 by September 1 (if attending Venturing, CB)
- Have week-long camping experience
- Be recommended by their unit or youth leader
