Gear List

- Shotgun** You should bring your own 12 gauge or 20 gauge shotgun. Since some stations on the course will present 2 clays in a quick succession, an over-under, side-by-side, semi-auto or pump is a necessity. All clays and shot shells for the day are provided as part of the team fee.
- Pistol** We will provide 9mm pistols for your use on the range. If you want to bring your own 9mm it must have open (factory) sights. No scopes / lasers allowed. The range we are using is a COLD RANGE. No loaded firearms are allowed anywhere, except on the line under supervision of the range officer.
- Ear Protection** Please bring your own shooter ear muffs, ear plugs, or other hearing protection.
- Eye Protection** Please bring your own shooter eye-glasses or other eye protection.
- Shot Shells** Please **do NOT** bring your own shot shells. To make this event as fair as possible to all participants, shot shells from one manufacturer with the same shot size and load are being used. All shot shells for both the morning and afternoon events will be provided.
- 9mm Ammo** Please **do NOT** bring your own handgun ammo. To make this event as fair as possible to all participants, handgun ammo from one manufacturer is being used. All handgun ammo for both the morning and afternoon events will be provided.
- Hull Bag** Bringing a Shooting Vest or Hull Bag is your call. All shells will be handed out at each station. There are collection barrels for hulls at each station. Please help us keep the course clean by putting your hulls in the barrels. Thank you!
- Water** Water dispensers and cups will be positioned at each station for you to use. If you want to bring your own water or non-alcoholic beverage you can.
- Beverages** Alcoholic beverages are absolutely forbidden during the hours of the shooting portion of our event, 9:00 a.m. to the end of shooting, around 5:00 p.m. Consumption of alcohol during the hours of shooting will be grounds for immediate expulsion from the event and the course.
- Sun Protection** We encourage you to wear a hat and to use sun-screen. There is not a lot of natural shade at the site.
