



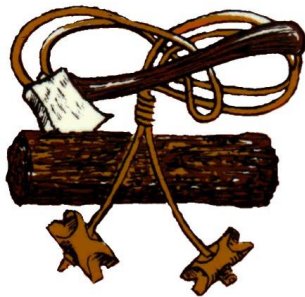
# “Every Leader Deserves to be Trained”
